Selden's V-Mix Sustainability

We have looked at how many VMix bottles we have bought over this period and extrapolated to how many RTU trigger bottles would have been produced if we had supplied a customer with ready-to-use trigger packs.

Total VMix bought in the last 12 months 5203 cases... each case contains 6X1ltr bottles which totals 31218 bottles... times this by 100 as each 1ltr bottle can produce 100 X 750ml trigger bottles.

Pearroc has saved 3,121,800 RTU plastic bottles and trigger spray heads from being produced and entering the waste stream.

Looking at the transport alone from Selden to us... That works out to 166 full articulated wagons full of ready-to-use trigger sprays that never left Selden... If we total up all the individual deliveries to Pearroc of VMix, these Super Concentrates were delivered on just 2 trucks.

164 trucks saved !!!

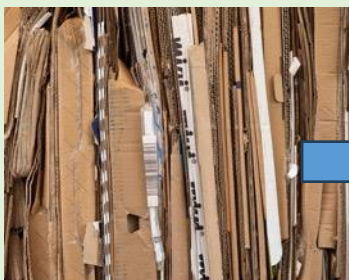
Lorraine is also keen to encourage new and younger membership, confirming that the WCEC is for everyone, not just the older generation.
